#### As We Gather

There was an old television show called To Tell the Truth. By means of questions and answers, the panel was to guess which of the three contestants was the real subject. This, of course, meant that the other two had to lie their way through their answers. In many ways, we are confronted with the same struggle between the truth and the lie every day.
