As We Gather

False prophets or preachers are those who attempt to gather a following by, for instance, "prosperity preaching" or a "health and wealth" gospel that is no true gospel at all. Christian disciples know that life will not always be easy and that faith is often tested in times of trouble; storms will come. Our Christian faith enables us to weather the storms of life. Faith relies on the mighty Word of God; for faith is the hand that grasps God's Word and then does something with it. Yet even the "doing" of the Word is the activity of the Spirit in us through the Word causing us to bear fruit. God has provided the "materials" to build the shelter. He even provides the blueprints, the wisdom, and the strength of faith to do the required assembling, remembering that "unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain" (Psalm 127:1).







Matthew 7:15–23

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the seventh chapter.



P ¹⁵[Jesus said:] "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. ¹⁶You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. ¹⁸A healthy

tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. ¹⁹Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.


